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FINANCIAL STATEMENT BY SPONSOR

To the Sponsor:

It is assumed that you have been asked to financially sponsor a participant to the Doctor of Ministry program. It is further assumed that you have been given information about the program and that you believe that it is worthwhile for the one you are sponsoring to attend.

Briefly this is a summary of what the participant is financially required to pay to complete the course.

TUITION

➤ Four classroom modules: \$900 each	\$ 3,600
➤ Four non-resident electives: \$500	\$ 2,000
➤ A Project dissertation	<u>\$ 1,000</u>
TOTAL TUITION FEE	\$ 6,600

TRAVELING EXPENSES, VISA, FOOD AND LODGING

Modules are held in Seattle and in one Asian country (India, Philippines, or Hong Kong). To attend these four modules, held in two, two week sessions, it is estimated that the cost would be about:

Seattle: Round trip air fare from Asia –
US\$ 800 plus \$100 a day for 2 weeks (\$800 + \$1,500) and visas \$2,500
Manila, India, or Hong Kong, as required.

The entire program, it is estimated, would cost about ten thousand US dollars. This includes – tuition, transportation, food and lodging. Comparable international doctoral programs cost between \$15,000 – \$20,000 for tuition alone, this is considerably less.

Note that each student must pay before each module, tutorial and project is given. The student will not be allowed to progress in the program until all accounts are current.
